1. GENERAL

1.1 Introduction

This Supplement to the Flight Manual provides information and limitations applicable when a basket with door and / or passenger seat is used. The arrangement and numbering of sections in this Supplement is the same as in the Flight Manual. If any section is influenced, only the different or additional information is stated in this Supplement, all other remain without any change.

2. OPERATION LIMITATIONS

2.13 Fitment interchangeability

The basket with the door or the passenger seat installed must only be flown under the envelope fitted with Rotation Vent.

2.14 Other Limitations

Basket door

The door must remain closed and both hinge pins secured during the entire flight.

Passenger seat

The seat, trestle and attachment system must not be damaged. The passenger in the seat must be seated and wear the harness during the entire flight.

4.2 Assembly of Balloon and Pre Take-Off Checks

4.2.1 Balloon preparation

Additional information for assembling the balloon:

When the pilot chooses to use the seat, it should be installed into the basket prior to cold inflation. The procedure is described in para 7.7.5

Always lay the basket with the door closed and on the other side than that with the door.

In addition to the standard check inspect the following:

Basket door	Check correct function
Seat	Check its attachment to the basket floor

Instruct the passengers not to touch the door hinge securing carabiners.

4.2.2 Pre take-off checks

In addition to the standard check inspect the following:

Passengers in the seat	Sitting in the seat with harness correctly worn and adjusted
Door	Closed and secured on both sides

In addition to the standard check inspect the following:

Passengers in the seat	Sitting in the seat with harness correctly worn and adjusted
Door	Closed and secured on both sides

4.3.9 Landing

In addition to the standard check inspect the following:

R	otation vent	Rotate the balloon to have sitting passenger(s) back to the direction of flight and to land on a basket side other than that with the door


7.7.3 Basket Door

Basket door is an optional equipment for an easy embarking and disembarking of passengers, mainly elderly or disabled persons. The door is to be open only on pilot's instruction prior to take-off before the balloon has been released from the quick release; and after landing.

The door and its frame structure is made of stainless steel tubes, wickerwork is done in the same manner as the standard basket wall. The door is hinged on both sides and can be open on either side or even completely removed by removing the continuous hinge pin on desired side. Securing the pins is provided by attaching the pin lugs to the door frame lugs with carabiners.

WARNING:

Both door hinge pins must be secured during the entire flight!



7.7.5 Passenger seat

Passenger seat is an optional equipment designed for easy installation and removal by the pilot without using tools. The composite seat with upholstery and four-point restraint harness is supported on a stainless steel trestle that attaches to the basket floor by four corner pins and a central bolt.

Seat installation:

- 1. Insert the pins in the underside of the trestle into the groove in metal plates on the basket floor and slide the seat sidewards to fasten all pins.
- 2. Screw in the central bolt and tighten with hand.

NOTE:

The correct orientation of seats must be taken into account. All seats must be installed so that orientation with all seating passengers back to the direction of flight before landing is possible.


During pre-flight preparation:

The weight and floor area occupancy of the seat is to be taken into account. The actual weight of the complete set is engraved on the trestle.

Floor area occupied by the seat: 0.27 m^2 (2.9 sq. ft)
